# PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Olive Endoscope Transportation Cart ensures ease of handling scopes. It considerably prevents cross-contamination and risk of scope damage during transit and cleaning. The large tray offers ample space for coiling the endoscopes in large hoops as per the SGNA endoscope transport guidelines.

# INTENDED USE

The Olive Transportation Cart is designed to transport flexible endoscopes from the procedure room to the storage cabinet for reprocessing and clean endoscopes back to the procedure room.



### MAINTENANCE AND BEST PRACTICES

**CAUTION**: The user is responsible for thoroughly cleaning and maintaining the transportation cart to ensure optimum functioning.

- 1. Do NOT coil the insertion tube or the universal cord of the endoscope with a diameter of less than 12 cm
- 2. Clean and disinfect the trays thoroughly on a regular cleaning protocol, or when the sinks becomes soiled.

### **CLEANING, DISINFECTION & CARE**

### **Cleaning the Trays**

Do not use abrasives, such as steel wool, wire brushes or scrapers on the stainless steel and PMMA fiber surface.

**CAUTION**: For plastic surfaces and acrylic plastic (PMMA Fiber) components, use a hospital-approved disinfectant. Avoid disinfectants that have glycol ethers as an ingredient. Do not use alcohol or ammonia.

### **Cleaning Stainless Steel Body of Transportation Cart**

- 1. Remove dirt, blood, and other organic soil.
- 2. Always clean the trays prior to disinfection to avoid compromising the disinfectant's effectiveness.
- 3. Dust first, then remove any stubborn deposits with a damp sponge.
- 4. Using a soft cloth, clean with a non-abrasive, neutral liquid detergent at a 10-20% solution. Use a stronger concentration in the presence of excessive dirt.
- 5. Lightly rinse before disinfection, being careful to minimize moisture in the sinks.
- 6. Avoid using bleach for cleaning or disinfecting your sink's surface, as bleach causes permanent damage through oxidation and staining.

Given below is a list of materials/ agents that are approved to be used to clean Body of Olive Transportation Cart:

- 1. Soft, lint-free cloth
- 2. Mild detergents
- 3. White vinegar in a spray bottle
- 4. Sodium bicarbonate (Baking Soda)
- 5. Cleaners approved for use on Stainless Steel/Galvanized Iron
- 6. Non-abrasive cleaning pads
- 7. Isopropyl alcohol
- 8. Soft bristle brushes
- 9. Distilled water (pH rating 7.0) solely or with mild detergent

### 10. Hospital-grade non-bleach detergent

| CLEANING MATERIALS TO AVOID | CLEANING AGENTS TO AVOID   |
|-----------------------------|--|
| Abrasive pearls             | Hard water (water with a pH above 7.0)   |
| Scrapers (metal or plastic) | Hydrochloric Acid  |
| Steel wool                  | Steam or high pressure water on PMMA tray  |
| Wire brushes                | Bleach/ any compounds containing chlorine or sodium hypochlorite, or ammonium chloride salts |

<sup>\*</sup>Steam or high pressure water may be used to clean stainless steel body

### REPAIRS AND REPLACEMENT
